

FREE SAMPLE CARD

A sample worth keeping

Record the same span before and after finishing. Keep the yarn label and a small swatch with this sheet. Use your own measurements, not an assumed fiber percentage.

Project / sample ID and date

Yarn, color, dye lot, and label length / weight

Loom, structure, threading repeat, EPI and PPI

Finishing process: wash, dry, press, and measurement state

Measurement	Before finishing	After finishing
Body width in reed / finished width		
Marked on-loom / finished cloth length		
Sample net dry mass (g)		

Width loss = (reed width - finished width) / reed width.

Cloth length loss = (on-loom cloth - finished cloth) / on-loom cloth.

Keep warp yarn take-up separate from these cloth measurements.

Swatch location / anything to change next time

FREE PROJECT CARD

A clear plan for the next warp

Project name / purpose

Finished cloth width, length, and number of pieces

Sett (EPI or ends/cm) / on-loom pick density

Measured width loss / cloth length loss

Warp yarn take-up / extra weft path allowance

Outside waste / sample length / gaps between pieces

Final body ends / floating ends / actual reed width

Warp length to wind per end

Warp yarn to buy / weft yarn to buy / reserve included

Yarn colors, package sizes, and quantities to purchase

Include hem cloth in finished cloth length. Outside waste includes outer fringes; gaps include neighboring fringes. Buying reserve does not lengthen the warp. Examples are not tested weaving patterns.
